The Archdiocese of Boston established Life Resources in 1971 with a mission to serve at-risk and in-crisis adolescents and their families with acceptance, respect and dignity; regardless of race, religion, or national origin. The agency runs three residential treatment programs in Massachusetts – The Pilgrim Treatment Center for boys located in Braintree, The Phaneuf Youth Treatment Center for boys located in Brockton, and the Bishop Ruocco House Treatment Center for girls located in Lakeville. The youth participating in these programs have experienced abuse, neglect and exploitation. Many of these boys and girls have had problems at home, in their schools and communities. In many cases, they have turned to crime and ended up in the Juvenile Justice System. Each residential program offers a home away from home where the adolescents attend school, receive counseling services, and learn behavioral and daily living skills. The programs, which operate 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, make remarkable progress in helping these kids turn their lives around. To learn more, visit www.liferesourcesinc.org.
